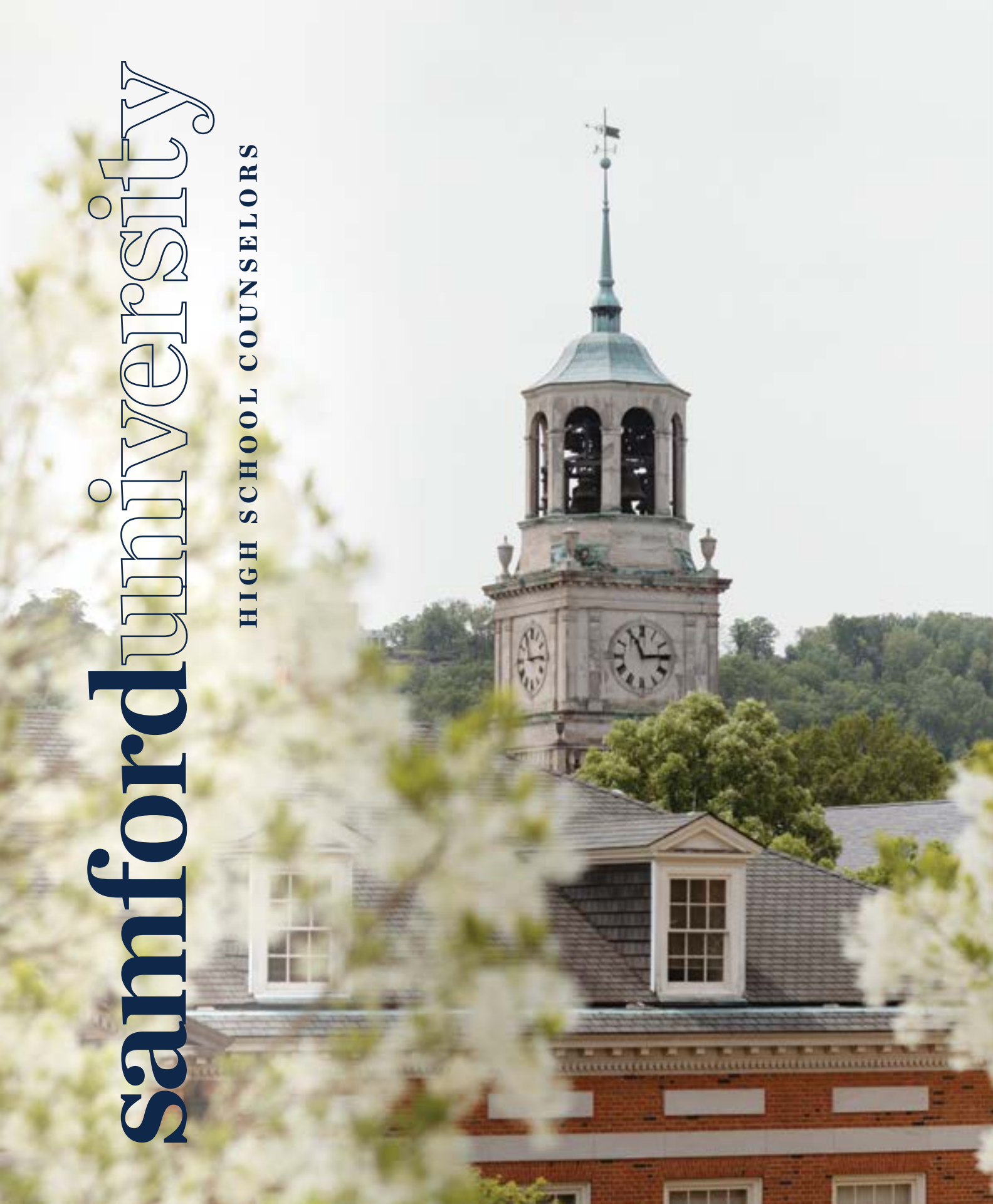

Our scholarships represent a purposeful commitment to the future of each student. Samford offers merit-based awards for academic achievement and service, including:

- Crosland Scholarship (\$15,000 average for academic achievement)
- Davis Scholarship (\$2,000 for outstanding community engagement and service)
- Marion Scholarship (\$11,000 average for embodying Samford values and a positive community impact)
- Ragland Scholarship (Four-year cohort experience for leaders amongst our multicultural students)
- Sherman Oak Scholarship (\$1,000 for family members of Samford students or graduates)
- Need-based Aid (Submit a FAFSA to Samford by February 15)

We also offer program-specific scholarships, transfer scholarships and other awards.

Due to a limited availability of standardized tests, we will give freshman applicants the option to be evaluated without a test score for the 2021-22 application cycle.
